IS CASH STILL KING? YOU DECIDE!

In today's world, if you try and deposit, or do business with, a large amount of cash, you are going to have to prove that it is "clean".

The result is that, today, most people do not engage in transactions involving any significant amount of cash funds.

Instead, today, deposits in bank accounts and/or credit are accessed electronically for most business transactions.

In other words, for much of business transacted today, "Cash has largely been replaced with a bank electronic tally".

This has allowed the world banking system to provide speed, convenience, and credit to customers, facilitating their transactions.

But, recently, many banks have become mired in regulatory problems and credit provided by banks to customers has become scarce.

This has, in turn, caused a very serious negative impact on the ability of businesses of all sizes to do business.

The downturn in business activity has, in turn, fueled loan defaults, worsened credit problems, and caused widespread economic failures with closing or "downsizing" of businesses and job losses.

CREDIT AND REGULATORY COMPLIANCE SOLUTIONS

BUSINESS CANNONS Business Group Revenue Sharing Obligation ("RSO") Bonds empower issuers to include gold in their portfolios.

Similarly, qualified buyers may acquire U.S. Treasuries and/or other valuable instruments, paying only 1% of value out-of-pocket plus 100% repaid through contracted future business.

RSO Bonds, U.S. Treasuries, etc., being inserted into portfolios can provide credit worthiness as well as compliance with regulatory requirements.

As for the 1% costs indicated, in the event acceptable payment for that is not otherwise available, a work-task assignment may be negotiated and executed to comply therewith.

PAYING DEBTS

If there is an outstanding debt, irrespective of amount, that has to be paid, the party owing the debt may arrange for the BUSINESS CANNONS Business Group to provide payment.

As indicated above for RSO Bonds and/or U.S. Treasuries, the cost would be 1% of value out-of-pocket plus 100% repaid through contracted future business.

As before, the 1% might also be negotiated to be paid through work task fulfillment.

Payment arranged through the Business Group would always be in the form of a 'Bill of Exchange'.

Typically, this would be a fractionalization of a referenced 'Bill of Exchange' issued to provide a larger amount as payment for a Purchase Order.

To be collected a Bill of Exchange thus issued could be sent to an escrow/attorney firm designated for that purpose. The escrow/attorney would perform the banking function of collecting the Bill of Exchange once its underlying conditions have been satisfied.

Additionally, the escrow/attorney would offer to sell 'Bills of Exchange' held to a Private Asset Management Group. Although others might be used, the Business Group has incorporated specific Asset Managers that are engaging in buying/selling of large quantities of oil products.

These Asset Managers have agreed to use income from the oil products contracts, which have been arranged for them, to buy Bills of Exchange held by the escrow/attorney.

As indicated above, Bills of Exchange can be issued and sent for collection as per the described protocol. However, a 'Bill of Exchange' might also provide immediate relief to a debtor. There is ruling precedent indicating that "payment" and "funds" may include money, a check, a bill, property, or anything of value.

Thus, a 'Bill of Exchange' backed by provable value, accompanied with a verifiable and valid collection procedure, might be endorsed and provided as payment for a debt.

The party being paid would be provided the collection procedure and coordinates.

Whether or not a party owed a debt has to accept the 'Bill of Exchange' as payment is a contractual issue to be reviewed by competent legal counsel.

Thus, Members of the Internet Catalogue Club wishing to use this procedure to satisfy debts are encouraged to have their situation and this procedure reviewed by their attorneys.

JOBLESS

An unemployed person might "spread the word" about the above, showing banks, businesses, and individuals that there is a positive way out of the mess that has been created.

By doing so, a person could create a very significant personal income.

IN THE END

In the end it comes down to a very simple equation. There are massive blockages in the world economic system that may take a very long time to be corrected.

But, the Business Group offers ways that can be used, without waiting, to solve financial problems that an individual, a corporation, a municipality, a financial institution, etc., may be facing!

Until such time as normalcy returns, the Business Group recommends that everyone be "flexible", cooperating and accepting proven value that is already scheduled to provide traditional bank deposits. Alternatively, business might be contracted to be closed once a 'Bill of Exchange' presented as indicated has been collected or bought.

This last strategy is currently being used very successfully to contract for real estate purchases!
